These students also shared how through *Journey's* online fellowship they were able to receive spiritual and practical insights that equipped them with exactly what they needed to handle different circumstances experienced in college. They also expressed how praying for one another, sharing their learnings from the devotions, being open about their struggles, and being accountable to one another has helped them greatly appreciate being in fellowship with other believers, especially in this pandemic.
