Love in Action

1 John 4:7–19 | Dr. Stephen G. Tan

Discussion Questions

- 1. What is the craziest expression of love that you have seen or heard?
- 2. We all know and understand the emotion of love because we've all experienced loving another person, but the expression of love in action comes in many different forms. What does the Bible teach about love in action? Read 1 John 4:7-19.

God is the author of love; He gets to define its expressions and actions (v. 7-8). Why did John encourage Christians to love one another? What is the connection between loving and knowing God? How is your definition of love different from how God defines it? Why does God set boundaries in the way we should express love?

Love is sacrificially giving something to those who do not deserve it and cannot hope to attain it (v. 9-11). How did God show His great love to undeserving people like us? What makes His demonstration of love so great and sacrificial? How do you respond to God's sacrificial love for you? Is it easy to love other Christians? Why or why not?

Our sacrificial love helps the world understand God's love for them (v. 12-16). As a Christian, how do you know that you live in God and God lives in you? What makes it difficult to love another Christian? On the other hand, what are some sacrificial ways you can show that you love your fellow

Christians? How do you think doing this would impact the people around you who do not know Christ yet as their Savior?

Love demonstrated on the cross and lived out ensures confidence when facing the ultimate Judge (v. 17-19). What would be the purpose of a believer standing before the Judgment Seat of Christ in the future? Why should you not fear this judgment for all believers? In what ways have you been emulating God's love and demonstrating it to others?

Reflect & Respond

Our Lord Jesus Christ demonstrated His perfect love for us when He showed it through His sacrificial action by dying on the cross for us. How do you respond to His unconditional love? How can you help the world to understand God's love for them? What specific steps could you take to demonstrate your love for a brother or sister in the Lord?
