Enjoy Life with a Purpose

MESSAGE

NOTES

For one's life to mean something and have a purpose, it must be lived for the Lord. The book of Ecclesiastes gives us three biblical principles for how we can enjoy life with a purpose.

Live to enjoy life RESPONSIBLY (v. 11:9-10)

 The privileges God has given us must be balanced by personal responsibility.

Live for a SPIRITUAL PURPOSE (v. 12:1-2)

 As a child of God you are called to revere Him, keep His laws faithfully, and serve Him responsibly because He is your Creator.

Live with ETERNITY in mind (v. 12:6-7)

- The decisions you make today will reverberate throughout eternity.
- Living life with eternity in mind helps us to press on and persevere amidst life's challenges.

REFLECT and DISCUSS

- 1. Take a few minutes to talk about the message. What part of the teaching had the most impact on you?
- 2. How have you been enjoying your life so far? Does it speak of a life that is fun, enjoyable, and at the same time glorifies the Lord?
- 3. How do you remember God in your daily life? When you meet Him face to face, would it be with guilt or with expectation that He will call you a faithful servant, a faithful child?
- 4. In what ways are you living with eternity in mind? How does it affect how you live your life right now?
