NOTES

Fangirling or fanboying over some famous person is not a new concept. We see this happen in biblical times as Jesus went about His earthly ministry. As Jesus taught Scripture and performed miracles, His fame and follower count grew and grew. But there's a big difference between being a fan and being a genuine follower. John 12:12-26 gives us three action steps that a true follower of Christ must do for life transformation to happen:

Recognize Jesus as the True King in our lives (v. 12-16)

Lead others to Jesus through our personal testimony (v. 17-22)

Live a life of sacrificial service for the sake of eternal things (v. 23-26)

4. Which of the three action steps are you struggling with? What makes it difficult for you? Are there any adjustments you need to make in your life so that you can experience the life transformation that being a genuine follower of Christ brings?
