MESSAGE

NOTES

What makes a person worthy to be honored? We tend to admire, honor, and associate with people we perceive to be great, powerful, and famous regardless of their character, but Proverbs 31:10-31 reminds us of eight biblical qualities that we should celebrate and praise, look for in a person, and cultivate in ourselves.

8 Qualities that Make a Person Worthy to be Honored

- Trustworthy
- Sacrificial
- Industrious and hard-working
- Caring

- Protective of family
- Upright and honorable
- Speaks wisdom and truth
- God-fearing and prayerful

REFLECT and DISCUSS
