NOTES

Two important questions to ask as you journey through life:

WHERE AM I GOING?

- Is the destination truly worth the journey?
- Is the place accessible?

HOW DO I GET THERE?

- What's the path you need to take?
- What are the costs involved in getting there?

REFLECT and DISCUSS

1. Take a few minutes to talk about the message and share observations about the Bible passage:
 - What were the two critical questions the disciples asked Jesus in John 14:1-6?
 - How does Jesus describe heaven in John 14:2-3? How does the imagery of "many rooms" in heaven affect your understanding of what Jesus is preparing for us?
 - What does Jesus mean when He says, "I am the way, the truth, and the life" in John 14:6? What are the implications of Jesus being the only way to the Father for people of other faiths or beliefs?
2. How does the promise of heaven as a welcoming home prepared by Jesus influence your daily life and decisions?
3. How can you share the message of Jesus being the only way to eternal life with someone who might be seeking multiple paths to salvation?
4. Identify one area in your life where you might be relying on good works rather than faith in Jesus for your spiritual assurance. How can you shift your focus to trust in Jesus' finished work on the cross?
5. How can you cultivate a deeper excitement and anticipation for heaven in your daily walk with Christ? What practical steps can you take to remind yourself of this promise?
