## NOTES

### THREE LIFELONG LESSONS ON RADICAL CHRISTLIKE HUMILITY

1. Put the interests of others above mine (v. 3-4)
2. Exalt God alone, not myself (v. 5-7)
3. Obey God at all cost (v. 8)

## REFLECT and DISCUSS

1. Take a few minutes to talk about the message. Note key characteristics of Christ-like humility described. Talk about the part that specifically stood out to you.
2. On a scale of 1-10, how have you been reflecting Christlike humility?
3. Reflect on specific ways can you practice Christlike humility before others:
  - Identify a specific area in your life where pride has caused disunity. What steps can you take to address and overcome this pride?
  - Are there people you need to forgive or ask forgiveness from? What is holding you back, and how can you take the first step towards reconciliation?
  - How can you serve others selflessly in your home, workplace, or community this week? Provide a specific example.
  - Who are the most difficult people in your life to serve? What practical actions can you take to serve them with humble, sacrificial love?
4. How can you make regular self-reflection on your humility a part of your spiritual practice? What questions will you ask yourself to ensure you are growing in humility?
5. In what ways can you promote unity within your church or small group? Identify one specific action you can take this week to foster a spirit of unity.
