2. Paul describes Jesus as the image of the invisible God and the Creator and Sustainer of all things (Colossians 1:15-20). How does this understanding of Jesus influence the way you approach your daily relationship with Him?
3. What are some examples in your life where you've only prioritized God in moments of crisis or urgency? How can you shift to prioritizing Him consistently, even when life feels less urgent?
4. The message highlights the authority and worthiness of Jesus because of His role in creation and His sacrifice for us. How does recognizing this change the way you view your daily routines like prayer, Bible reading, or worship?
5. Think about an area in your life where you have been neglecting to prioritize Jesus. What specific steps can you take this week to put Him first in that area?
