Talk It Through

1. Easter is supposed to be the celebration of the greatest victory ever—Jesus conquering death and offering us eternal life. But if salvation is the “ultimate prize,” why do you think we sometimes stop treating it like one? Have you ever had a season where being a Christian felt more like a burden than a joy? What do you think causes us to lose the wonder of what Jesus has done?
2. What did the resurrection mean to Jesus’ disciples in Luke 24—and what does it mean for us today? How does knowing Jesus is alive change the way we see our problems, doubts, or fears?
3. If someone looked at your life this past week, would they see someone who’s living in the joy of the resurrection? What might need to change so that joy becomes more visible?
4. What’s one simple step you can take this week to live out the resurrection more fully—whether in believing God more deeply, sharing your faith with someone, or choosing joy in your day-to-day life?
