### » Talk It Through

1. Have you ever made a choice you knew was right, but it ended up costing you something—like a friendship, an opportunity, or comfort? How did you feel about it at the time, and how do you see it now?
2. Based on the message, what stood out to you about how God's judgment is different from how the world usually judges people and choices? Why does that matter for how we live?
3. If you could look at your everyday choices through "eternal eyes," what area of your life do you think would look different? Would you say that your recent decisions (big or small) have been more about honoring God or more about protecting yourself or pleasing others? Why do you think that is, and where do you tend to lose sight of the bigger picture?
4. What's one decision you're facing (or an area you're struggling in) where you can ask yourself, "Does this honor God and reflect Christ?" How can you intentionally practice that this week?
