Talk It Through

1. "Waiting is hard." That's something we've all said or felt at some point. What's one situation where you really struggled with waiting—big or small? What made it so difficult?
2. From Psalm 130 and the message, what stood out to you about how God meets us in our waiting? How does that shift the way you view seasons of waiting?
3. When you're in a season of waiting, do you tend to lean into God or pull away? What does your usual response reveal about where you place your hope?
4. Why do you think honest, unfiltered prayer is so important in seasons of waiting? How does that kind of honesty actually build hope instead of weaken it?
5. Who in your life needs a little hope right now? How could you share part of your story (or something from Psalm 130) to help point them back to God?
