**** KEY TAKEAWAYS ****

Habakkuk asked God two questions: “Does God not hear our prayers?” and “Why does God allow evil to go unpunished?” God’s answer reveals to us how He operates:

- God’s ways are beyond our understanding
- God enacts justice in unconventional ways
- No one escapes the judgment of God

Talk It Through

1. Have you ever felt like God was silent or slow to act when you prayed about something unfair? What was that experience like for you?
2. From Habakkuk’s story, what stands out to you about God’s character in dealing with injustice? How does the way He works differ from how we usually expect or want things to happen?
3. When you see wrong or unfair things around you, what’s your usual first response—anger, discouragement, or trust? Can you recall a time when God’s answer came in an unexpected way but later made sense?
4. What’s one step you can take to choose faith over frustration when life feels unjust? How might you practice trusting God’s timing and wisdom in the coming week, especially when things don’t make sense?
