Talk It Through

1. How do you feel about the statement, “I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth”? Do you agree that seeing others grow in faith brings a unique kind of joy—especially if you’re a parent? Why or why not?
2. What stood out to you from the message about the role of family and community in shaping a person’s faith?
3. Who were the adults or mentors you looked up to most, and what made their presence meaningful to you? Was there someone who had the greatest influence on your walk with God? What do you think made their impact strong?
4. In your current stage of life, how can you be intentional about influencing younger believers—or even your peers—to walk closer with Jesus? (For parents: what are some ways your faith, whether strong or struggling, has already shaped your children?)
5. For Parents: Looking at your daily rhythms at home—mealtimes, conversations, routines—where do you see opportunities to more intentionally point your children toward God? What small step could you take this week?
