- 3. What did the message teach you about how God views humility and how He responds to the humble? What did you learn about how humility grows when we depend on God, whether for His timing, His help, or His truth over the enemy's lies?
- 4. Which area do you personally find hardest right now: trusting God's timing, admitting your limitations, rejecting the lies of pride, or giving God all the glory? Why is that particular area especially challenging for you?
- 5. What is one practical way you can practice humility this week at home, at work, or in your relationships, whether by waiting on God's timing, seeking His help, resisting pride, or intentionally giving Him the glory?
