2. What stood out to you about how the Messiah leads, His wisdom, His fairness, and His care for people? What does this show you about what God is really like?
3. The sermon described a future where natural enemies like wolves and lambs will live peacefully together. What are your honest thoughts about that kind of reality? How does that future promise speak into the fears or anxieties you're carrying right now?
4. If the King has shown His worthiness through sacrificial love, what's one area of your life that still resists His authority? What would it look like to actually surrender that to Him this week?
