** KEY TAKEAWAYS**

The way we respond to Jesus in the moment reveals the kind of devotion we truly have

- True devotion recognizes Christ for who He is and responds fully in heart, worship, and surrender
- Misplaced devotion is not centered on Christ. Even when it looks spiritual, it still misses Him
- True devotion responds faithfully in the moment God gives us, because it may not come again

Talk It Through

1. The sermon said the way we respond to Jesus in the moment reveals the kind of devotion we really have. If you had to be honest, do you see yourself more in Mary or Judas in this story? What makes you say that?
2. Mary and Judas were in the same room, seeing the same Jesus, but responding very differently. What does this show about the difference between true devotion and misplaced devotion? What do you notice about how Jesus responds to each of them?
3. When you look at your life right now, what tends to drive your decisions more, love for Jesus or things like comfort, image, or control? Where do you see that showing up?
4. Is there something you feel God has been nudging you to do that you've been putting off? What would it look like to take one step and respond this week?
