Talk It Through

1. Families often struggle when people stop taking responsibility for the roles God has given them. In your experience, what are some common ways people avoid responsibility in family relationships?
2. Looking at the different responsibilities God gives to husbands, wives, parents, children, and all family members, what stood out to you the most? What does this teach us about God's design for family relationships?
3. When conflicts happen in your family, do you tend to fight for your way, withdraw, keep the peace at all costs, or something else? How has that approach helped or hurt your relationships?
4. The sermon challenged us to be a blessing, not an enemy, to our family members. What is one specific way you can intentionally encourage, serve, or bless someone in your family this week? What can you do to help strengthen a relationship in your family and contribute to a more God-honoring home?
