» Talk It Through

1. Have you ever heard something about a person you trusted that made you question them, only to later discover there was more to the story? What happened?
2. The Rabshakeh tried to create doubt, while Hezekiah responded with prayer. What does this contrast teach us about faith, and what did you learn about God from His response?
3. What voices or influences today tend to weaken your trust in God, fear, criticism, social media, bad experiences, unanswered prayers, or something else? When your faith is shaken, where do you usually turn first for reassurance, yourself, other people, or God? What does that reveal about your heart?
4. What's one situation in your life right now where you need to trust God more? How can you bring it before Him this week in a way that seeks His honor, not just your preferred outcome?
