Talk It Through

1. In the passage, the nobleman traveled a long distance to seek Jesus because his son was in crisis. When life feels overwhelming, what is usually your first instinct: try to solve it yourself, ask others for help, or bring it to God?
2. The nobleman believed Jesus' word before he saw any evidence that his son had been healed, and his faith eventually influenced his entire household. What does this story teach us about faith, trust, and the kind of relationship God wants us to have with Him? How can our personal faith impact the people around us?
3. The sermon reminded us that spiritual leadership begins at home and is seen in everyday life. If the people closest to you were asked what your faith looks like in practice, what do you think they would say? Which of the four areas discussed in the sermon do you feel needs the most growth right now?
4. Who are the people God has entrusted to your influence, whether family members, friends, younger believers, or others? What is one intentional step you can take this week to help them grow closer to Christ?
