Talk It Through

1. Have you ever waited for something for so long that you started wondering if God was even doing anything? What did that waiting season do to your attitude, thoughts, or faith?
2. Psalm 40 shows David looking back at God's faithfulness while he was still waiting for his current situation to change. What does this teach us about the difference between simply waiting for an answer and actually waiting on God?
3. Waiting has a way of exposing what is really going on in our hearts. When you're frustrated, uncertain, or not getting the outcome you want, what tends to surface most in you: impatience, fear, the need for control, resentment, discouragement, or something else? How much of your peace was tied to getting the answer you wanted? What does that reveal about what you may be trusting in?
4. The sermon says that surrender isn't absence of care, it is placing your care in the right hands. What is one situation you need to entrust more fully to God? What might surrender look like in a practical way this week?
